<p>Communication and Language: This half term we will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Talking about and comparing different festivals. Talking about why things happen and use new vocabulary. Recalling vocabulary from a favourite story. Showing good listening by joining in with class discussions. 	<p>Personal, Social and Emotional Development: This half term we will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Learning how to share with others, be fair and ask for a turn when turn taking. Using words to communicate likes and dislikes. Dressing appropriately for winter weather. Thinking of others and their feelings (link to Remembrance Day) Showing signs of being patient and waiting (link to Advent). 	<p>Physical Development: This half term we will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Trying to put our outdoor clothing on independently. Throwing, rolling and catching a ball. Using playdough during our 'Dough Disco' sessions to improve finger and muscle strength. Trying to use a tripod grip most of the time when writing. Using correct letter formation when writing. Beginning to form capital letters. Writing our own name with increasing confidence and independence. Developing our cutting skills when using scissors. 	<p>R.E. This half term we will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Continuing to explore Baptism in our topic 'belonging'. Being welcomed into church and God's family. Looking forward to Jesus' Birthday and preparing for Advent which is a time of waiting. Answering how and why questions based on our personal experiences. Responding in different ways about beliefs, experiences and feelings.

<p>Mathematics: This half term we will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Identifying, naming and comparing circles and triangles. Describing position. Finding, subitising, representing and composing numbers 1-5. Finding one more and one less within 5. Identifying, naming and combining shapes with 4 sides.

<p>Understanding the World: This half term we will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Identifying familiar celebrations. Talking about Remembrance Day – Who are we remembering and why? Remembering things that happened in the past, a long time ago, such as Guy Fawkes and Bonfire Night. Observing the natural process of freezing and melting in the outdoors.

<p>Expressive Arts and Design: This half term we will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Using primary colours to make secondary colours by colour mixing. Using tapes and glues to join materials together. Describing sounds such as loud, quiet, fast slow. Taking part in many role play scenarios including acting out the Nativity story for an audience.
