## Communication and Language:

This half term we will be:

- Applying our new learned vocabulary ourselves inside and outside of teaching sessions!
- Understanding longer adult instructions, and follow them to change our line of play, to complete an adult job or routine.
- Taking part in increasingly long interactions between peers and with adults, learning about conversation.

## Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

This half term we will be:

- Attempting to voice our opinions more during play and consulting an adult if we need to.
- Developing our understanding of our emotions and how we can manage these independently using our setting, or with a grown up.

## Physical Development:

This half term we will be:

- Building our control and safety when using scissors independently in the workshop.
- Making large muscle movements in response to music during our Squiggle While You Wiggle sessions!
- Challenging ourselves physically outdoors, using gardening tools and completing obstacle courses!
- Developing independence during toileting.

- Learning about Lent in preparation for celebrating Easter.

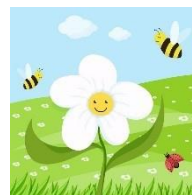
## Reminders:

## Mathematics:

This half term we will be:

- Exploring position and routes.
- Exploring patterns
- Consolidating our current counting skills
- Learning about action words and movements.

## Understanding the World:

This half term we will be:

- Observing seasonal change and signs of Spring.
- Learning about the preparations during Lent and the celebration of Easter.
- Exploring how we grow!
- Exploring how plants grow by planting our very own sunflowers to take care of.
- Learning about the life cycle of a chick.

## Expressive Arts and Design:

This half term we will be:

- Developing our mark making skills to ensure meaning.
- Ensuring we are using one tool at a time and that our older children are confident at choosing which hand they would like to use to make marks.
- Making attempts at writing our own name, with more precision on our initial sound formation if we are approaching our Reception year.

## Literacy:

This half term we will be:

- Working on familiarising ourselves with our own name (spotting it with and without our picture)
- Continuing our NELI sessions each day, alongside our core texts to build our familiar stories.
- Sequencing and discussing specific parts of a story such as the characters, the end and beginning.
